R.N.Kapoor Homoeopathic Medical College, Dr. A.P.J Abdul Kalam University, Campus, Indore- Dewas Bypass Road, Gram Arandia, Madhya Pradesh Indore-452010 has submitted an application for permission for sanction of 100 seats in BHMS course for the academic year 2023-24. The College has submitted the Part 1 information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. The college was inspected dated 24/08/23 and 25/08/23 and report is received. MARB has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Standard requirements to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under NCH Act 2020.

As per the shortfalls made by MARBH, following lacunae are to be rectified with immediate rectification of the shortfalls. College shall fulfil all functional requirements as per the Minimum Standard requirements as mentioned below.

- 1. Hospital details:-
- Case records shall be submitted against the direction issued from MARB. IPD and OPD case records (copy of one OP and one IP cases of 1st and last day of every month) shall be submitted for verification.All follow up attendance should be recorded on the case records.
- Case records should be maintained with demographic details of the patient such as name, age sex, address, phone number etc.
- Case sheets shall be maintained with complete case analysis and evaluation and repertorisation and made available in medical record room for academic purpose of students.
- Lab investigation report should be maintained properly in case records.
- Disease diagnosis shall be recorded in all case records as per ICD 11 criteria.

2. College Departments:-

- In Anatomy Department Mummified body/ dry body is not available for surface teaching
- In Pharmacy Department: only first three volume of homoeopathic pharmacopeia are available.
- 3. **Miscellaneous details:** -Biometric attendance of staff shall be provided with arrival and departure time.

- 4. Financial details:
- Form -16 shall be submitted from traces portal.

Considering the above observations, and facilities available, MARB has decided to issue conditional permission to R.N. Kapoor Homoeopathic Medical College, Dr. A.P.J Abdul Kalam University, Campus, Indore- Dewas Bypass Road, Gram Arandia, Madhya Pradesh Indore-452010 for conducting BHMS course for the academic year 2023- 24 with intake capacity of 100 seats.

All the shortfalls observed in your College are fundamental in nature and shall be rectified within a period of 30 days or before counselling initiates whichever earlier, and compliance report shall be submitted to the MARB, failing which the conditional permission issued will be cancelled without further notice.

All admissions shall be made from NEETqualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/ UT govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the central govt for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.

The category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
